

Diocesan Lenten Appeal - DLA - Update

This week each of our four Catholic parishes saw an increase in their Diocesan Lenten Appeal (DLA) effort. Each parish increased their numbers on average 4%. The report for this week is as follows:

Saint Joseph - Goal = \$37,946 — Raised to Date = \$53,510 = 140%

Saint Mary - Goal = \$35,961 - Raised to Date = \$35,510 = 98.7%

Saint Margaret Mary - Goal = \$125,124 - Raised to Date = \$107,150 = 85.6%

Mount Saint Peter - Goal = \$102,481 — Raised to Date = \$82,640 = \$80.6%

** With the numbers as indicated, it appears St. Mary will get to goal sometime this coming week.

If increases continue at a 4% rate, St. Margaret Mary and Mount Saint Peter will be at goal in about 4 to 5 weeks. This is a great accomplishment for all four of our parishes.


