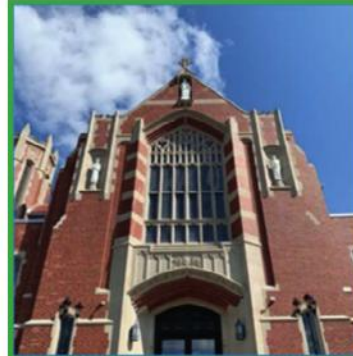

Both Saint Margaret Mary and Saint Mary of Czestochowa Parishes join Saint Joseph Parish in exceeding their Diocesan Lenten Appeal goal. Mount Saint Peter is not far behind.

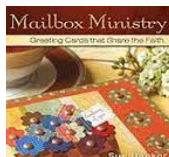

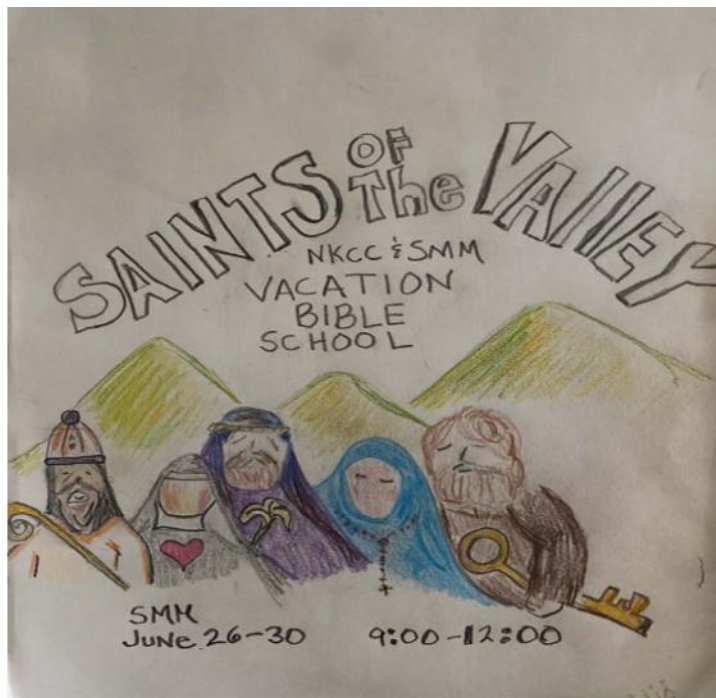
