



You may have noticed the beautiful piece of new artwork in the Narthex recently.

Fr. Ken provided this information about the piece.

My sister-in law, Patty – received a Christmas gift (2021) from my brother for 'stained-glass' classes. She is extremely talented, and for this past Christmas (2022) she made me a stained-glass window of the 'lion and the lamb'.

Upon receiving it this past Christmas day, I knew that in order to do this piece of artwork justice, it would need to be in a wooden frame with back-lighting.

I asked Bishop Kulick if he knew of someone who could build such a wooden frame box for me that would house this 'lion/lamb' stained-glass. Bishop Kulick gave me the name of a solid Catholic man

from Indiana county – Jim Pencola. I contacted him, and he constructed the perfect frame with backlighting that would house my Christmas gift from 2022.

My brother hung this art-work in the narthex of Saint Margaret Mary.

Whenever the day occurs and I get transferred or retire, this particular piece of artwork will follow me.
