

Father Elpidio, or as he prefers Fr. Bimbot, is currently the parochial vicar of the Mt. St. Peter, St. Joseph and St. Mary of Czestochowa Parishes in New Kensington and St. Margaret Mary Parish in Lower Burrell.

Father Bimbot was born on June 4, 1978 and is the youngest in his family. He is a pure Filipino and was ordained a priest on February 12, 2010. He came from the diocese of Tagum, Davao del Norte, Philippines. Before coming to America, he was the administrator of Sto. Rosario Quasi-Parish and also administrator of Via, Veritas et Vita diocesan Retreat House of Tagum.

Father Joel is currently the parochial vicar of the Mt. St. Peter, St. Joseph and St. Mary of Czestochowa Parishes in New Kensington and St. Margaret Mary Parish in Lower Burrell.


