



Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

A Message for all Eucharistic Ministers at Saint Margaret Mary, Mount Saint Peter, Saint Joseph and Saint Mary of Czestochowa.

"Please do your best to attend an evening of renewal for Eucharistic Ministers at Saint Margaret Mary on Monday, November 13 at 6:30 pm in the Church."

In our Diocese of Greensburg, the right to serve as a Eucharistic Minister is a gift offered to the Eucharistic Minister by the Bishop. Typically, the commission to serve in this role, once accepted and approved by the Bishop, is for a period of three years. Every three years, names are submitted to the Bishop for his approval. Our diocese requests that a continual effort be made to support the Eucharistic Minister in training and in understanding their role.

In conjunction with this request, the Eucharistic Ministers of Saint Margaret Mary, Mount Saint Peter, Saint Joseph and Saint Mary of Czestochowa Parishes are encouraged to attend an evening of reflection on the role of the Eucharistic Minister. The reflection will take place at Saint Margaret Mary Church on Monday, November 13 starting at 6:30 pm. The session will include evening prayer, a Eucharistic film, best practices, questions and answers. Session should conclude at approximately 8:00 pm. The "renewal" commissioning of all Eucharistic Ministers will occur in the "home" parish of each Eucharistic Minister on the First Sunday of Advent, December 2-3.
