

Father Ken's Lenten Note

"Come Through the Narrow Gate"

Back when I was in college working on my thesis for my Bachelor's Degree, my "professor/advisor" said to me over and over again, "You will have to narrow your thesis. Cut out the extraneous and prove a single point." He wanted me to focus my thinking, to make it sharp and penetrating, not spread all over the map. He reminded me of Ralph Waldo Emerson's lament, "if only I knew how to omit!"

The Entrance to
Heaven is Through
a Narrow Gate

Jesus wished his contemporaries and us to live to the point,

to focus our lives, to omit, the things that weigh us down with items that are meaningless. Jesus never took the broad way that led to nothing but despair and frustration. In a sense Jesus was narrow, intolerant of the byways that went nowhere worth going.

The gate to life is a narrow one of spiritual discipline. It takes us along a hard way, often calling us to do what we would rather not and not to do what we would rather. It leads us up a rugged trail, "far from the maddening crowds" on the broad way below. It lures us from the tempting valleys where integrity surrenders to deception.

No person ever achieved greatness in any area without being narrow, without learning to omit. Albert Einstein was narrow, omitting the things that would have cramped his genius. George Washington was narrow, doing what he would rather not for the sake of our country. Saint Paul was narrow, saying to himself, "This I the one thing I must do." Like the pearl merchant in the Master's parable, we are constrained to sell all our little pearls for the one of great price. Socrates sensed the necessity for narrowness when he visited the Athenian fair and remarked, "There is so much here that I do not want."

The road to Heaven is Narrow, the path to greatness is Narrow, reaching the Cross of Christ is Narrow, our focus needs to be Narrow to achieve any and all.







CATECHESIS CORNER - WHAT DO I DO DURING EUCHARISTIC ADORATION?

When you enter the Church you will see Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, exposed on the altar inside a gold monstrance, which is shaped like a sunburst to magnify the glory of His presence. If able, get down on both knees and reverently bow before Jesus before getting into or after exiting the pew. If unable to do so, show another form of reverence to

the Lord such as genuflecting, bowing, and making the sign of the cross.

Once in your pew, there are no rules other than remaining reverent and silent. You can sit, kneel, stand and change your position as often as you would like. Speak to the Lord from your heart, listen to him through reading sacred scripture, pray the rosary, sit in silence, write in a prayer journal and/or read religious books. Help your little ones come into the presence of the Lord by offering them stories of the saints to read, or invite them to write or draw in a "prayer journal" where they can draw pictures for Jesus or write him messages and prayers. You may invite them to color in religious coloring books to help keep their mind focused on Jesus. The important thing is to be present with the Lord, rest in him and let the Holy Spirit guide you.

PASTORAL STAFF
