- To accommodate your intentions, you are encouraged to combine several family members in one Mass Intention, such as: "Deceased Members of the Smith Family" or "John & Mary Jones."
- A \$10 Mass stipend per Mass intention must accompany this form. Please mark your envelope "Mass Intention Requests" and mail to the parish office. The Mass intentions will be opened and scheduled in the order in which they are received.
- All Mass intention requests will be scheduled by the parish office staff. The date or dates you request will be entered into the Mass Book as close to the day(s) as possible if the exact day(s) cannot be honored. Once requests are scheduled in the Mass Book you will be notified by mail. Thank you for your cooperation.
