Congratulations, Mount Saint Peter Parish!

I congratulate Mount Saint Peter Parish for reaching their Diocesan Lenten Appeal (DLA) goal, and reaching it by the collective gifts of many. This marks the first time in three years that Mount Saint Peter's goal was reached as an accomplishment of many and not as a bill to all.

As I have mentioned many times before, both in my bulletin notes and by way of my DLA letters to all of my four parishes, that every parish will always reach its goal, one of two ways— either through the collective effort of all, or by being “billed” by the diocese to the parish that falls short of its goal and receiving a “bill” that reflects the amount reached, and the amount not reached short of the assigned DLA goal.

Last year for example, Mount Saint Peter Parish received a DLA “bill” for \$1,710.00 (one thousand seven hundred and ten dollars) because our parish of Mount Saint Peter fell short of its DLA assigned target by \$1,710.00.

Great work Mount Saint Peter's! Not only will we not have to receive a bill this year to reach our DLA goal, but we will receive money back “**tax free**” because we are 9.3% over our assigned goal.



Catechesis Corner

CATECHESIS CORNER - ASCENSION

This Thursday we celebrate the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus into Heaven. The Ascension signifies Jesus' **literal bodily return to heaven**, where He now sits at the right hand of God. **It represents His victory over death and His exaltation to a position of authority and glory.** Many onlookers saw and bore witness on that day of Jesus' ascension. As a cloud began to hide Jesus as he ascended, two angels appeared to the disciples and promised that Christ would “return in the same way you have seen him going into heaven.” Acts 1:11. As Jesus told His Apostles, “But I tell you the truth, it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate will not come to you. But if I go, I will send Him to you.” John 16:7. Jesus did not leave us as He ascended into Heaven but is with us until the end of time. We only need to receive Him into our hearts.



The question was asked: “Why do we ring the bells at Mass?” The use of bells during Mass is a long standing tradition in the Catholic Church. This typically occurs **after the consecration** when the priest elevates the Sacred Host or the Chalice of Precious Blood. The bell is rung to signify that the bread and wine has been transformed into the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. The Body and Blood of Our Lord is truly present on the altar. Bells were historically used in divine worship to alert the congregation that something important is happening and to create a joyful noise before the Lord.

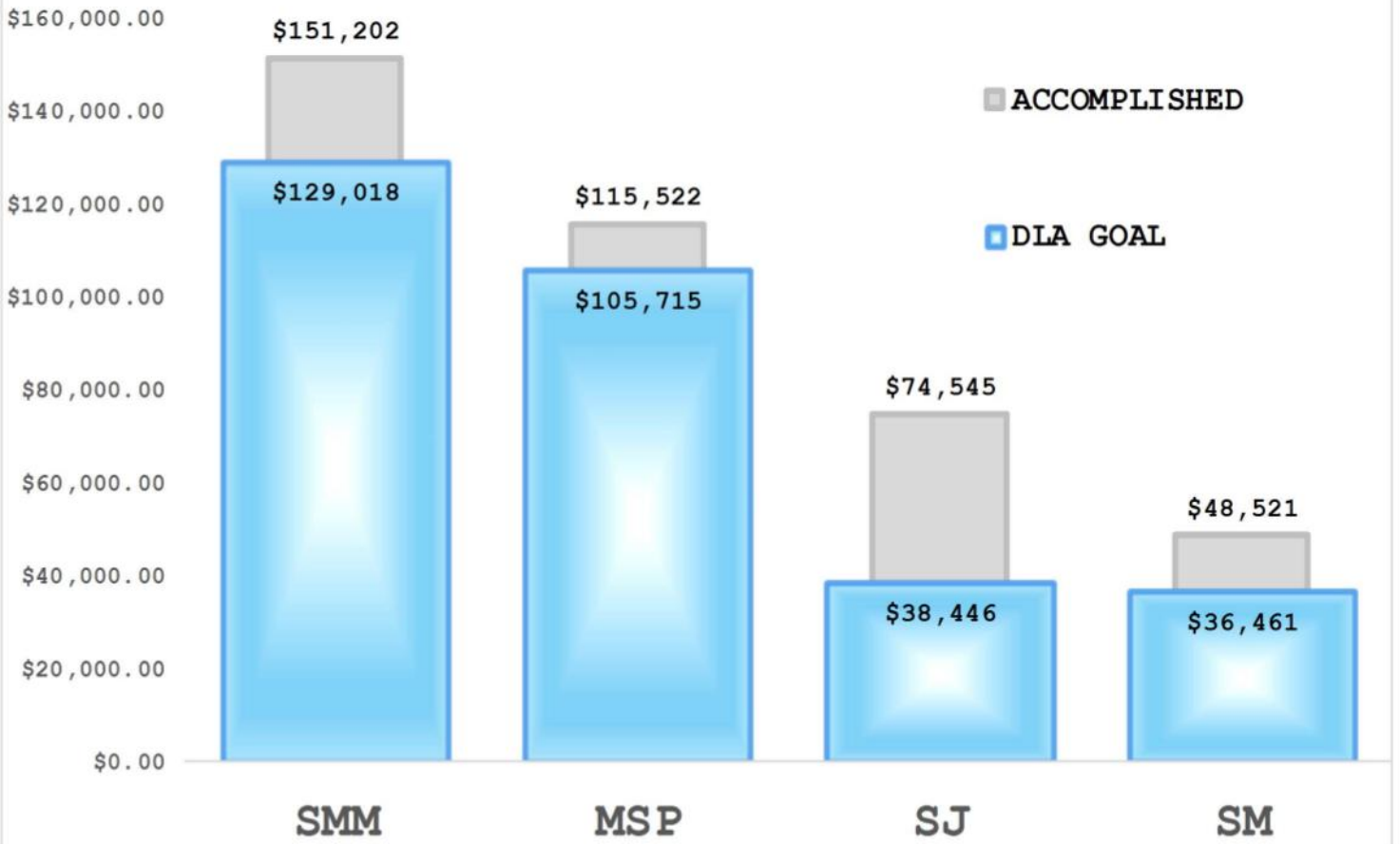
