



Father Ken's Note...

DON'T JUDGE TOO QUICKLY, THIS WILL PREVENT YOU FROM HAVING TO APOLOGIZE!

A father and his daughter were playing at the park. The young daughter spotted a man selling apples. She asked her father to buy her an apple. The father didn't bring much money with him, but he had enough money to purchase two apples. The father's daughter selected two apples from the pile of many, and she held on to the two apples as her father paid the bill.

The young daughter held one apple each in her two hands. As the father was waiting for his daughter to hand him an apple, she took a bite from one of the apples and slowly let the bite in her mouth swish around as she was grading its flavor. Then, to the father's surprise, she took a bite from the other apple and let that bite swish around her mouth as she was grading the flavor. At this point



the father started to feel disappointed that his daughter did not hand him one of the apples so he could start to enjoy one apple as she was now in the process of enjoying both. The father was saddened that his daughter was not sharing. He was disappointed in himself as he started to question the teaching role, he performed in teaching his daughter the importance of sharing, he wondered "did she learn what he taught her about sharing, by her actions obviously not." The father was just getting ready to tell his daughter how disappointed he was in her for taking one bite out of each apple and not sharing. 


