Father Ken's Note...

WHY DO SOME PEOPLE ACHIEVE AND OTHERS DO NOT?

There were two warring tribes in the Andes, one that lived in the lowland and the other that lived high in the mountains. The mountain people invaded the lowlanders one day, and as part of the plundering of the people, they kidnapped a baby of one of the lowlander families and took the infant with them back up into the high mountain.

The lowlanders didn't know how to climb the mountain. They didn't know any of the trails that the mountain people used, and they didn't know where to find the high mountain people or how to track them in the steep terrain. Even so, they sent out their best party of fighting men to climb the mountain and bring the baby home. The men tried first one method of climbing the high mountain and then another, and all the methods they used failed. They tried one trail and then another, but every trail they used to climb the high mountain, got them nowhere. After several days of effort, they realized that they had climbed only several hundred feet.

Feeling hopeless and helpless, the lowlander men decided that the cause was lost, that they would not be able to retrieve the baby and so they prepared to return to their village below with the unfortunate news. As they were packing their gear for the descent, they saw the baby's mother walking toward them. They realized that she was coming down the high mountain that they could not figure out how to climb. To their surprise they saw that the mother had the baby strapped to her back. How could this be they wondered? How did she make it up the high mountain when they could not?

One man greeted the mother and said, "We could not climb this high mountain, how did you do this when we, the strongest and most able men in the village, could not achieve the feat of climbing the mountain as clearly as you have?" The mother shrugged her shoulders and said, "The difference—it wasn't your baby."

CATECHESIS CORNER - PENTECOST SUNDAY

"I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son, is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets." We proclaim these words each time we recite the Nicene Creed at Mass. We also pray, "Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love." So who is the Holy Spirit?

The Holy Spirit is the shared love of God the Father and Jesus the Son pouring out upon those who have placed their faith in Jesus Christ, been baptized and confirmed. The Spirit comes as divine light to comfort us, strengthen us and guide us toward goodness and trust in God. The Spirit is the third person of the Holy Trinity, also called the Paraclete or Advocate. **The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. 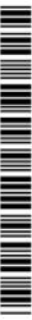
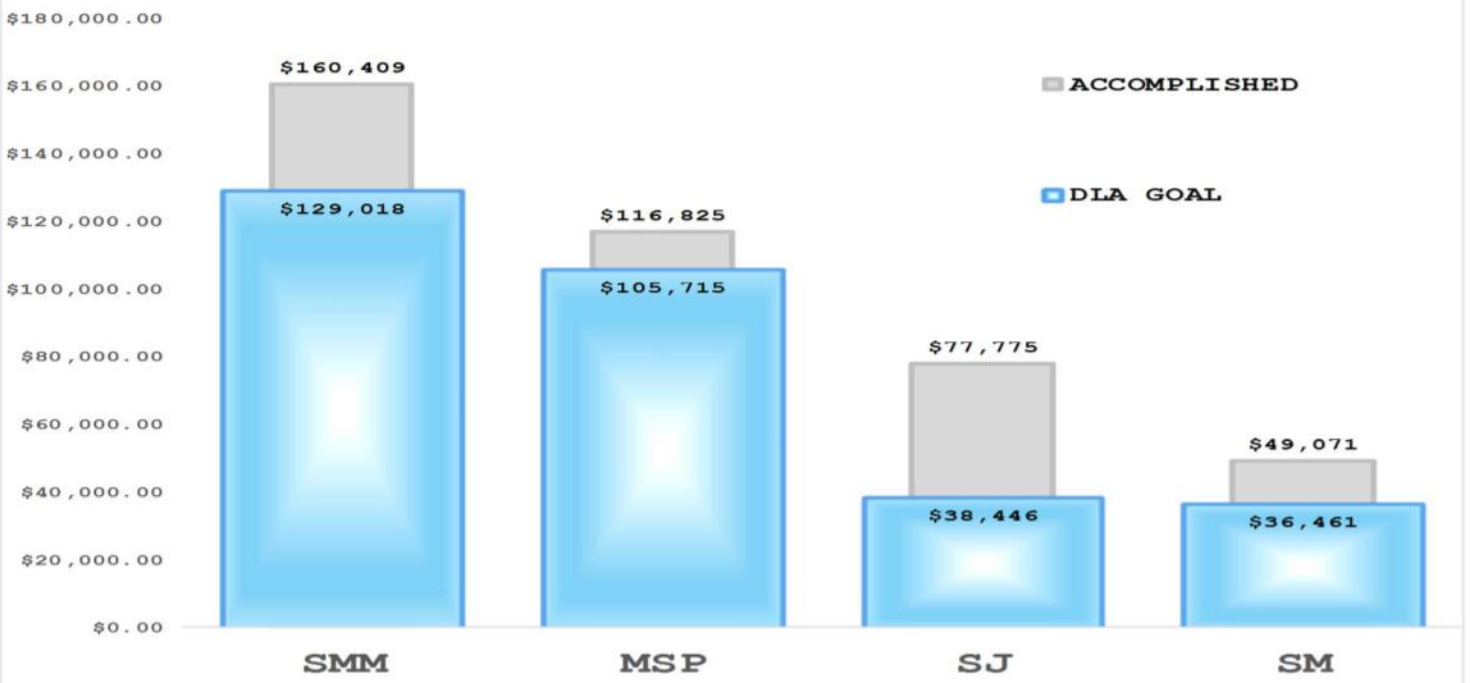
