

WHAT YOU SAY TO A CHILD OR DON'T SAY TO A CHILD WILL AFFECT THEIR LIVES FOREVER.

One day Thomas Edison came home from school and gave a paper to his mother. He told her, "My teacher gave this paper to me and told me to only give it to my mother." His mother opened the paper and read the note that it contained to herself first, then after reading it to herself, she read it out loud to her son, "Your son is a genius. This school is too small for him and doesn't have enough good teachers for training him. Please teach him yourself."

Many years after Edison's mother had died. Edison had become one of the greatest inventors. One day he was going through his Mom's old house getting it ready for sale, when he ran across the very paper with the note inside that he received from his teacher, the note only meant for his mother. He opened the note, and to his surprise, he read something completely different than what his Mom told him the note said. Now. reading the note to himself he was shocked and tears streamed from his eyes, as he read, "Your son is mentally ill. We cannot let him attend our school anymore. He is expelled."

After reading the actual message of the note, Edison wrote the following in his diary, "Thomas Alva Edison was a mentally ill child whose mother turned him into the genius of the century."

NEW SOUND SYSTEM AT MOUNT SAINT PETER

After months and months of waiting and one supply chain issue after another, all the components needed to install our new Mount Saint Peter sound system finally arrived and were installed last week. This past weekend, May 25-26, we had our inaugural testing



of the system. The reviews received were positive and appreciative. Because of the generosity of our Mount Saint Peter parishioners, the sound system, with a price tag of \$59,653.00, has been paid in full.

CATECHESIS CORNER - SEMINARY FORMATION

For every Catholic priest, his time of training, discernment, and formation for the priesthood began at a seminary, a word derived from the Latin word meaning "seedbed." Seminaries are not merely "priest factories" where men go and learn what it takes to become a priest, but rather through prayer, spiritual

direction, and living in community, they come to better understand and prepare for whatever God is uniquely calling them to do in the future. While at a seminary, the seeds of a seminarian's vocation—or calling from God—are cultivated through incremental growth and development in spiritual, human, intellectual, and pastoral ways.

Seminarians spend the first two-to-four years of formation (depending on how much education they had received prior to entering seminary) learning philosophy and how to establish a daily prayer routine and love for the sacramental life of the Church. After earning thirty Philosophy credits and receiving a bachelor's degree if they do not already have one, seminarians will advance to a major seminary elsewhere—if they still feel called to be a priest—for four years of graduate studies in Theology. During these years, they will receive weekend and summer assignments at different parishes, visit hospitals, practice celebrating the Sacraments and preaching homilies, and will be ordained to the transitional diaconate within their final year of formation; a necessary step on the path to priesthood. The Sacrament of Holy Orders is plural in name because every man will be ordained a deacon before he is ordained a priest, and a priest before he is ordained a bishop, if appointed one by the pope.
